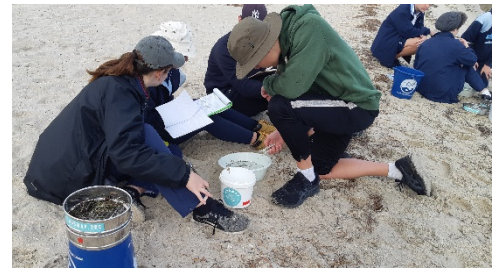




HUNTER ENVIROTHON – 7 JUNE 2023

Glenrock State Conservation Area



At Envirothon, different schools enter teams of four students from Year 10 and 11, to compete in a challenge event in the local area linked to the curriculum areas of Geography and Science along with Environmental Education.

Each school team will investigate this location through practical fieldwork activities to address a challenge question. Activities include:

- Analysis of water quality.
- Investigation of vegetation.
- Investigation of human impacts, human use and management.
- Consultation with local stakeholders regarding issues and management.
- Examination of the site history including Aboriginal history.

Students use the data collected to formulate a response to the challenge question which is presented to a panel of judges.

This is a **free** event for Department of Education Schools.
